- ◆ Generations of Faith meets monthly, beginning in October and ending in April.

  - Wednesday Evenings from 6:00pm-9:00pm
  - Saturday mornings, from 9:00am-noon
- ◆ Each gathering includes a pot-luck meal
- ◆ We use a variety of approaches—sometimes as a total group, sometimes people are invited to go into specific age-appropriate groups
- ◆ Our theme this year is Sacraments. Each month we'll explore the depth and mystery of one of the seven sacraments we celebrate as a church
